Quality Seal: Accessibility at Music Events

Certify your event or space so it can be enjoyed
by all people

What is it?

The Quality Seal: Accessibility in Musical Events will certify musical events or spaces that comply with universal accessibility.

For example, at events with this seal, all people, with and without disabilities, can:

- Find out more and get tickets for the event.
- Arrive at the event and move within its venue.
- Enjoy the music concerts.
- Access and use all of its services. For example, consume at the bar counters and use the toilets of the venue.
- Communicate your accessibility needs to the event organization.



Universal accessibility.

A characteristic of a place, a product or information that is used or accessible to all people.

A certification created by and for all people
